





## Huddersfield Rugby League: A Lasting Legacy Art and Writing Prize Competitions

## **Competition Rules**

- 1. The competitions will run from the summer of 2013 to a closing date of Friday 4 April 2014.
- 2. The theme for the competitions is The Life Story of Douglas Clark
- 3. The competitions will be divided into five age groups: Years 3 and 4; Years 5 and 6; Years 7 and 8; Years 9 and 10; Years 11 and 12.
- 4. All entries must include the entrant's name and year group
- 5. Winners will be decided and prizes awarded by the organisers, the Steering Group of Huddersfield Rugby League: A Lasting Legacy. Winners will be announced on Friday 6 June 2014.
- 6. Prizes will include sets of 50 Huddersfield rugby league Collectors Cards, a Huddersfield Rugby League Book, and match tickets to watch Huddersfield Giants. They will be presented either at the school or at a Huddersfield Giants match. There will be framed certificates for wining schools.
- 7. Winning entries will be publically displayed as part of local rugby league exhibitions.
- 8. Entries may be produced in lesson time, by the children in their own time or at summer school, before school or after school clubs.
- 9. The same guidance and resources for the competitions, including photofilm and images that can be copied will be provided for each school.
- 10. Entries should be passed to Huddersfield Rugby League: A Lasting Legacy by one of:
