4b	Why?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the 22-10 Yorkshire Cup Final win against Hull KR in 1911 as it was the first trophy he won;</li> <li>• beating Australia 21-7 in 1911-12 as it is unexpected for a club team to beat a country;</li> <li>• the 37-3 win over St Helens in the 1915 Challenge Cup Final as it secured the historic fourth trophy that season</li> </ul>

11	What did your player do after he finished playing?	<b>Stanley worked as foreman-electrician at the Great Northern Street Works of Huddersfield's Passenger Transport Department; he played local amateur cricket for Primrose Hill and Huddersfield; he refereed; he coached Huddersfield's second team</b>
12	Write three adjectives to describe qualities that your player had as a person.	<b>Open answer, suggest three of: reliable; hard-working; industrious; intelligent</b>
13	What is the most interesting thing you have found about your player?	<b>Open answer</b>
14a	Is your player still alive?	<b>No</b>
14b	If not, when did he die?	<b>Stanley died on 23rd April, 1951.</b>
14c	What else do you know about his death?	<b>Stanley was 59 years old when he died. He died suddenly at home in Almondbury.</b>
