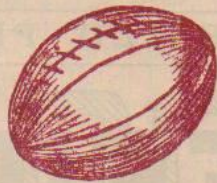

OFFICIAL NOTES.

The visit of Featherstone last Saturday yielded us our highest total of points in any game since we played Castleford on October 11th. Nine tries were scored, Madden obtaining four, Devery two, and Cooper, G. R. Pepperell and Valentine one each, the latter being the only forward to cross the line. Bawden kicked 4 goals, the last of these giving him his 100th point in club games. He now stands third in the league list of point-scorers and third in the goal-kickers. It was fortunate that, following keen frost on the Friday, the weather relented and our ground staff were enabled to get the pitch fit for play. The attendance was 5,348, receipts £414/6/3.

Keighley are welcome visitors to Fartown this afternoon and despite further mid-week frost we hope it will be possible to play the match and that some good football will be seen. The Airedale side have won six and lost eight of their fourteen league games, their victims including Hull, Dewsbury and Wakefield Trinity—

the two latter by substantial margins. To the many Fartowners who have found their way to Lawkholme Lane can be added the name of Tommy Clapham. Unfortunately, Clapham has been unable to play regularly owing to injury and he will not be on view this afternoon.

Our team will include our latest acquisition, M. J. Maiden, who has been signed from Featherstone Rovers. A former Welsh R.U. triallist, Maiden played for Newbridge before joining Dewsbury in July, 1946, his first R.L. appearance being against Huddersfield at Crown Platt on August 31st. In January of this year he was transferred to Featherstone and was in the Rovers team which defeated us at Post Office Road last April. Maiden is 25, stands 5ft. 10ins. and weighs 15st. We may also give a trial to a new hooker today.

Russell Pepperell will be unavailable this afternoon as he is taking Stott's place in the England team to meet Wales at Swansea. Congratulations to Russ. on his
