OFFICIAL NOTES

The visit of Warrington to Fartown this afternoon will inevitably conjure up memories of that Championship Final at Maine Road not so very long ago. What a great game that was, and how near we went to seeing Warrington snatch their irons out of the fire. This Final, along with that at Wembley in 1933, will rank among the finest ever.

Footballers may come and go, tries may be scored or disallowed, but so long as Huddersfield and Warrington can continue to produce the brand of Rugby we saw from them last season the code must progress.

It was, for Warrington, one of the penalties of the Top Four Play-off system that they should be denied the title of

R.L. Champions after having headed the League table throughout the whole of last season. But we welcome them to Fartown this afternoon as true exponents of the finer points of our game, and look forward to a tussle that will enhance the reputation of both sides.

Perhaps it will be our turn this season to reverse the League "double" which the "Wire" inflicted on us last time. A victory to-day will see us half-way there and will make an encouraging start.

Fartown Flashback—Do you remember?

Extract from our Official Programme of March 7th, 1931:—

"True to tradition, the eagerly expected match with the "Wirepullers" at Fartown produced a great struggle, culminating in a fine victory for Bowkett and his men by 11 points to 2. . . . A very good dribble by "Cherry" Thompson led to our first try, scored by Mills, while the winger followed this by racing 30 or 40 yards and sweeping aside all would-be tacklers to finally hurl himself over at the corner. Holding had been wide with several penalties but it was left to him to give Warrington their only points."
