"True to tradition the eagerly expected match with the "Wirepullers" at Fartown produced a great struggle, culminating in a fine victory for Bowkett and his men by 11 points to 2 . . . A very good dribble by "Cherry" Thompson led to our first try, scored by Mills, while the winger followed this by racing 30 or 40 yards and sweeping aside all would-be tacklers to finally hurl himself over at the corner. Holding had been wide with several penalties but it was left to him to give Warrington their only points."
