

Those were the days of Arthur Atkinson and Jim Croston, Cunnifie, McManus, Sadler and Co .- not forgetting the late Les Adams, a former Fartown scrum-half, who also joined the Wheldon Roaders. In 1935, Castleford gave the whole Rugby League in general, and we Fartowners in particular, a great shock when they defeated us in a Wembley Challenge Cup

Great days those, and although they may now be gone beyond recall the inspiration is there for the present day wearers of the amber and black jerseys. Last season's records showed Castleford to be in the lower half of the final League table-they won 13 of their 36 matches but they are hoping for better things this

They have, of course, in that experi-enced campaigner Ernest Ward, the right man to bring out the best in their younger players. Ward and those of his tried and tested colleagues such as Ken Pye, Albert Lunn, Denzil Webster, Anderson, Haughey, etc., will do a great service—not just to Castleford but to the game as a whole if they can restore some of those pre-war

They have our good wishes in the attempt-although we should add that we are hopeful and confident of a Huddersfield victory tonight!


