

A big hard-working forward and is a great asset to the code. A brother to the full back Bill Harrison. A Maori and a powerful goal kicker.

**H. (Munga) K. Emery** (Auckland), 27, married, 6ft, 15st. 9lbs. Occupation: Cargo worker. A former New Zealand Maori Rugby Union representative who is playing in only his second year of League. Represented New Zealand in both League Tests this year against the Australians. He won the Auckland Supporters' Club "Player of the Week" award for his performance in the first Test. Played for the coaching school against Australia.

**Sam Edwards** (Bay of Plenty), 24, single, 6ft, 11ins., 15st. Occupation: Bush contractor. One of the three 15-stoners in the side. A new Kiwi but narrowly missed selection in test teams earlier because of transfers due to his job. Played for the coaching school against the Australians. 
