



In season 1914-15, All Four major Rugby League Trophies were won by Huddersfield.

During the next full competitive season (1919-20) Huddersfield won three of the four Cups. In the Final for the fourth Trophy they were beaten by only one point, despite having five leading players away on Australian Tour duty and another unavailable through injury.



In Retrospect

CEASON 1957-58 proved to be yet another transitional one, with many team changes for one cause or another. As in the previous season, many players who have given good service left the club for varying reasons and team balance was upset after quite a promising beginning to the season.

Three former regular members of the side left early on. Jack Large retired following the recurrence of a hand injury, Peter Henderson returned to New Zealand, and Harry Bradshaw was transferred to Dewsbury. The team, however, proved worthy winners of the Yorkshire Challenge Cup in October.

That victory was followed by two heavy blows. Mick Sullivan, who had previously asked to be put on the transfer list, could not be persuaded to change his mind and was transferred to Wigan. Then, a week or two later, came the injury to Dave Valentine in a match at Hull. Dave broke his ankle (the third time he had broken the same ankle within 14 months) and he ultimately had to announce his retirement from the game.

Hopes of a revival were raised with a run of victories before Christmas but the annual holiday matches against Halifax resulted in two heavy defeats. The men from Thrum Hall also ended our Challenge Cup hopes in the first round at Fartown.

Many new faces were seen in the team during the second half of the season, during which period Brian Briggs was transferred to St. Helens.

The club's final League placing for 1957-58 was a poor one by Fartown standards but we are hoping for better things and for a more settled team during 1958-59.





The History-making Cheque



Rugby League history was made in the early hours of October 23rd, 1957, when Wigan paid £9,500 for the transfer of Michael Sullivan. This figure was well in excess of the previous highest amount paid for a player.

Sullivan's transfer was one of the biggest—if not the biggest—disappointments of the season. No-one at Fartown wanted him to leave—indeed the club could ill afford to lose him, especially as Peter Henderson, the only other experienced wingman on the books, had just gone back to his native country.

Sullivan remained adamant, however, and could not be shaken in his desire for a move. His request for a transfer was finally granted and within a few hours of the announcement he was a Wigan player.






